- We will continue to follow all CDC guidelines for sanitizing and spacing in curbside areas as well as inside the retail store.
- Going forward, curbside pick-up for both food and loose tea is still available, for those that continue to want this service. Call us with your order and cc# and we will leave it outside on the table next to the door.
- **All customers who enter our retail store must wear a mask**, for the safety of our staff and other customers. If you do not have one, we will provide a disposable one for you. Call us at 603-249-9111 before entering the store.
- Before entering the retail store, **please sanitize your hands in the entry way**. Please follow the arrows and respect the 6 ft social distance requirements.



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We are required by CDC regulations to provide this signage for all customers. If you answer **YES to any of these questions, please **DO NOT** enter the store.**

ARE YOU EXPERIENCING COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, INCLUDING:

- 1. Fever, or feeling feverish?**
- 2. Respiratory symptoms such as runny nose, nasal congestion, sore throat, cough, or shortness of breath?**
- 3. General body symptoms such as muscle aches, chills, and severe fatigue?**
- 4. Changes in your sense of taste or smell?**
- 5. Gastrointestinal symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea?**
- 6. Have you been in close contact with someone who is suspected or confirmed to have had COVID-19 in the past 14 days?**
- 7. Have you traveled on non-essential travel in the past 14 days outside of New Hampshire, Vermont, Maine, Massachusetts, Connecticut, or Rhode Island (this includes all travel, regardless of the mode of transportation, i.e., plane, car, ship, etc.)**
